## CONTAINER LABEL

A GUIDE FOR SUPPLIERS

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## CONTAINER LABEL

A label is required on each container/pack. This label must contain:

1. A scannable barcode of the unique container ID number (as appears on the ASN). This same number must be printed as a barcode on the container label. This barcode is scanned by the NDC operator at the point of delivery to identify containers received against the ASN. The container id should also be printed under the barcode and should be prefixed with the HOF PO number to ensure uniqueness amongst containers from other suppliers. E.g. 767892152901.
2. Human readable 4 digit destination Store Number
3. Human readable destination Store Location Name i.e. *Victoria, Lakeside* etc
4. Human readable HOF Purchase order number (central, store raised or replenishment)
5. Human readable ASN number
6. Human readable container/pack number (only necessary if you are labelling per store).

All container labels should be positioned on the box or container end panel.

This format will be available to use after July 2007.
